Poland is also one of the few EU member states that can claim positive GDP growth of 1.9% in the first quarter of 2009. Many foreign investors have already seen the potential and the country recorded a +35% of FDI in January 2009 compared with January 2008.

There are huge opportunities in Poland that await exploitation in a wide-range of sectors such as security, education and training, science and technology and generous EU funds are available. The European Football Championship in 2012 will also boost investment in infrastructure, roads, railways, airports and hotels.
