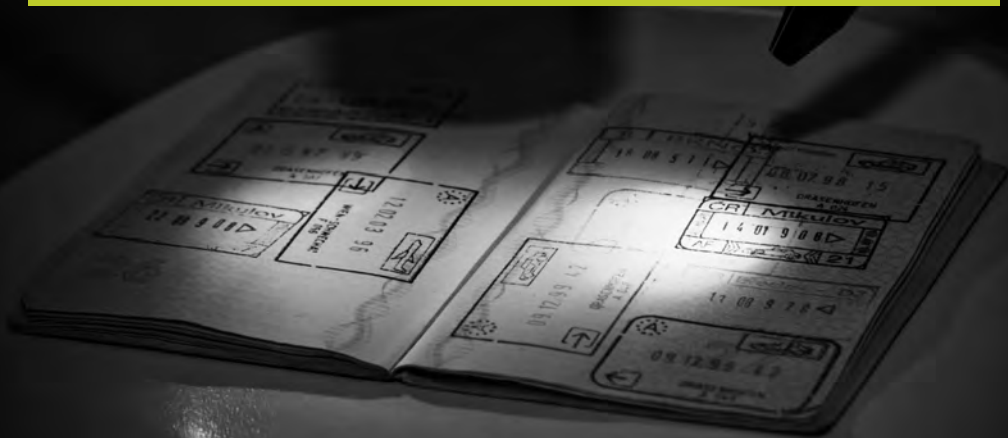

Ian has spent most of his career in work associated with the UK's armed forces. During the 1980s, he had roles at the NATO Defence College in Rome, HM Naval Base, Rosyth and the Arms Control Unit, before becoming assistant private secretary to the secretary of state for defence, then head of the MOD's Defence Lands Secretariat during the post-Cold War review of defence policy.

During the 1990s, Ian had roles as senior civilian on the staff of British Forces in Germany, he was managing director of the Defence Evaluation and Research Agency, and chief executive of what is now the Defence Estates Agency. Between 2002 and 2008, Ian served as second permanent under-secretary at the Ministry of Defence and as a member of the Defence Board with responsibility for transforming the effectiveness of the management of defence. He retired from the MOD at the end of March 2009.

He was appointed chair of the Serious Organised Crime Agency on 3 August 2009.
