





- UNGM provides access to UN business opportunities
- UNGM disseminates relevant UN procurement information
- 496,000 Suppliers
- 31K tenders were published by 63 organizations in 2024

The level is determined by the monetary value of contracts



UN Procurement Principles





UN Procurement – Selection Criteria

- Appropriate quality: Consider destination environment, skill level and availability of spare parts
- Value for Money
- Good after-sales service
- Reliable delivery
- Good Performance



Methods of Solicitation - Examples

- Electronic Tender Platforms (multiple)
- Sourcing

Expressions of Interest (EOI) or Request for Information (RFI)

• Request for Quotation (RFQ)

Informal method. Standard, Off the shelf.

Invitation to Bid (ITB)

Requirements are defined. Technically compliant, lowest cost.

Request for Proposal (RFP)

UN is asking for the bidder's expertise to formulate a complex proposal

Frame Agreements (LTAs)

- shorter lead-time
- improved quality control and supply security
- no minimum or maximum quantities guaranteed
- not exclusive to a single supplier
- binds suppliers to ex-stock deliveries
- competitive prices
- available to other members of UN Family

Top Tips to Winning Business with the UN

- Monitor Opportunities on the UNGM
- EOI Early Market Engagement
- Respond to solicitation requests when invited.
- Know the strategy for each solicitation Instrument
- Study the terms and conditions of the contract before drafting your offer
- Understand the requirements of tenders too many tender responses fail to meet minimum requirements
- Do not hesitate to ask questions/clarification before submitting your bid
- Be Responsive, Complete and Compliant in your offer
- Extend the validity of your offer Do not let your offer expire if you can maintain the price longer.

Top Tips to Winning Business with the UN

- Answer questions quickly If you receive a request for clarification of your offer.
- Go beyond price & Compliance Sustainability, Innovation & Story Telling showing data & facts.
- You have 85% of the products/services required, subcontract for the remaining
- Respect submission deadlines
- Don't mix up the envelops e.g price and technical offer otherwise disqualified!
- Ask for a debrief request feedback to help with future opportunities
- Find a local partner or have a presence in Country increase in sourcing close to the need.
- Persevere! Don't get discouraged normally takes several attempts to win the first bid

Navigating Global Uncertainty – UN Procurement

- Geopolitical Instability
- Funding cuts
- Supply Chain Disruptions
- Increased collaborations between the UN Agencies
 - Increase efficiencies, reduce costs and avoid duplication of work e.g collaborative procurement
- Agile procurement processes e-tendering
- Buying local close to the need.
- Sustainable Procurement
 - Choose suppliers with energy-efficient, recyclable, or reusable products to reduce lifecycle costs




