Trade and Cooperation Agreement

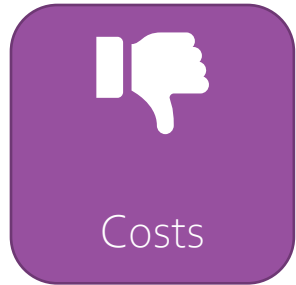
Key trade provisions of the TCA:

- ✓ Tariff and quota free trade
- ✓ Supports trade in services
- ✓ Applies only to the movement of goods produced between the UK and EU
- ✓ Arrangements for airlines and hauliers
